

First: - I direct that all my just debts and funeral expenses be fully paid as soon as conveniently may be after my decease
Second: - I give and bequeath unto my sister Amelia Becker the sum of five thousand dollars.

Third: - All the rest residue and remainder of my estate, real, personal and mixed whatsoever and wheresoever they same may be, I give devise and bequeath unto my wife, Amelia B. to her own use and benefit absolutely.

Fourth: - I do hereby authorize and empower my Executors hereinafter named, or the survivor of them, to sell and dispose either for cash or mortgage any of my real estate which they in their discretion may think best and to make, sign, seal execute, acknowledge and deliver the necessary deeds and conveyances requisite therefor to vest the same and to do the absolute for simple thereof, in the purchase or purchasers thereof, his, hers or their heirs and assigns forever, without any liability on the part of the purchaser to see to the application of the purchase money.

Fifth and lastly I do hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my said wife, Amelia B. and my brother-in-law Frederick D. Sangerheim, the Executors of this my last Will and Testament.
