Heath of the City of Camden New Jersey Executor of this my Will and I do authorize and empower him in his discretion to sell any part of my property real or personal for such price or prices as to him may seem meet and proper and to convey or transfer the same to the purchaser thereof without any liability to see to the application of the purchase money.
