Should the issue of my brother, or my nephew be deceased at the time of my decease, leaving issue surviving, I direct that such issue shall take the share his, her or their parent or parents would have taken, if living, in equal shares, absolutely and in fee simple.

Lastly: I nominate, constitute and apoint my brother Jacob F. Amon, and my nephew Aaron I. Sanson, Jr., to be the executors of this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all other wills by me at any time heretofore made, and declaring this only to be and contain my last will and testament. And for the better management of my said residuary real estate, I authorize and empower my said executors, and the survivor of them, at any time they may think it advisable, to grant, bargain, and sell the whole or any part thereof for such price or prices they may deem satisfactory, and upon such sale being made to grant and convey the same, or any part thereof by good and sufficient deed or deeds, or other instrument in writing, to the purchaser or purchasers thereof who shall not be obliged to see to the application of the purchase money thereof: nor be answerable for any non-application or mis-application of the same or any part thereof, and in the event of my said brother, Jacob F. Amon, ^{declining} dying, or refusing or becoming incapable to act as such executor then and in such case, I substitute, nominate and appoint my nephew Christian Walter Amon, as such executor, in conjunction with my said nephew, Aaron I. Sanson, Jr., to whom letters Testamentary shall be duly granted with all the powers and authorities given and granted to my executors herein.
