That an order be granted directing the service of the citation personally without the
State or by publication upon the persons hereinbefore named, described and included in
subdivisions a,b,c, and d hereof who are not residents of the State of New York, and also
upon the persons hereinbefore described and included in those subdivisions who and whose
names or residences and post office addresses are unknown and cannot be ascertained; and

That the last will and testament herewith presented and hereby offered for probate
may be admitted to probate as a will of real and personal property and that letters
testamentary may be issued to the executor who may qualify thereunder.
