I, Hermann Stubbendorff, a citizen of Pennsylvania, temporarily residing in Egg Harbor City, New Jersey, being of sound and disposing mind, memory and understanding, do hereby make my last Will and Testament as follows:-

FIRST: I direct that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid as promptly as possible after my death. I direct that my funeral shall be modest, and that only ordinary, reasonable expense shall be incurred.

SECOND: I direct that I be buried next to my wife, Mary Ellis Stubbendorff, in Laurel Hill Cemetery, Philadelphia.

THIRD: I give and bequeath to Bessie Macauliffe, a cousin of my wife, now living at 1818 Wallace Street, Philadelphia, the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1000).

FOURTH: I give and bequeath to Jonathan M. Steere, now living at Haverford, Pennsylvania, the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1000).

FIFTH: I give and bequeath to Girard Trust Company, of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, the sum of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300), the income to be used for the general care and maintenance of my lot in Laurel Hill Cemetery.

SIXTH: I direct that all inheritance or succession taxes on the above legacies, whether State or Federal, be paid out of my residuary estate.

SEVENTH: All the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, real, personal and mixed, and wheresoever situate, I give, devise and bequeath to my brother, Robert Stubbendorff, now residing at Angagare, Bara Station, Sweden, (via Malmo), if he be living at the time of my death, and if he should predecease me, to Robert, Hans, Knute and Elizabeth Stubbendorff, the children of my said brother, Robert Stubbendorff, their heirs, executors and administrators, absolutely.

EIGHTH: I authorize and empower the Executor of my Will to sell and make good conveyance thereof in fee simple, or for any less estate, any and all of my real estate, at either private or public sale, for such price or prices and upon such terms as to it may seem best, with power to take payment therefor in cash or partly in cash and partly in mortgage, or upon reservation of ground rents, without any liability on the part of the purchaser or purchasers to see to the proper application of the purchase money.

LASTLY: I nominate, constitute and appoint the Girard Trust Company, of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, to be the Executor of this my Last Will and Testament, and I specifically exempt it from the necessity of filing any bond in any State for the faithful performance of its duties.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, Hermann Stubbendorff, have hereunto set my hand and seal this 12th day of April, A.D. 1920.
