 Olof Bergman, deceased.
 Know all Men By These Presents, That I, Amelia Lucrecia Bergman, Executrix of the last will and Testament of Nils Bergman, late of the County of Cape May, in the State of New Jersey, deceased, am held and firmly bound unto Benjamin Erickson, Executor of the last will and Testament of Olof Bergman, late of the County of Atlantic, in the State of New Jersey, deceased, in the sum of Six Hundred Fifty Dollars and Six Cents, lawful money of the United States, to be paid to him, his successors in office or assigns, to which payment well and truly to be made, I bind myself, my heirs, Executors and administrators, firmly by these presents sealed with my seal. Dated the Fifteenth day of May nineteen hundred and seven.

Whereas, Olof Bergman, late of the County of Atlantic, in the State of New Jersey, deceased, in and by his last will and Testament, duly proved before the Surrogate of the County of Atlantic, aforesaid, did give and bequeath to his brother, Nils Bergman, the one third part of his Estate, after the death of Christina Bergman, wife of the said Olof Bergman, and Whereas, the said Christina Bergman has departed this life, and Whereas, after the death of the said Olof Bergman and Christina Bergman, the said Nils Bergman also departed this life, having first made and published his last will and Testament, in writing, in due form of law, wherein and whereby he devised and bequeathed all his property, real and personal, to his wife, Amelia Lucrecia Bergman, and constituted and appointed her the executrix of his will, and Whereas, Benjamin Erickson is the duly constituted executor of the last will and Testament of the said Olof Bergman, deceased, and Whereas, the said Amelia Lucrecia Bergman has duly proved the said will of the said Nils Bergman before the Surrogate of the County of Cape May, in the State of New Jersey, and Whereas, the said Benjamin Erickson has duly settled the estate of the said Olof Bergman, deceased, in the Orphans' Court of the County of Atlantic, and has a balance in his hands for distribution in accordance with the terms of the said last will and Testament of the said Olof Bergman, amounting to the sum of Nine Hundred Ninety Dollars and Nine Cents, of which sum one third thereof, amounting to the sum of Three Hundred Thirty Dollars and Three Cents, would have been payable to the said Nils Bergman, if living, and is now payable to and has been paid by the said Benjamin Erickson to the said Amelia Lucrecia Bergman, as the executrix of the said Nils Bergman, deceased.

Now The condition of This Obligation is such, that if any debt or debts truly owing by the said testator, shall be hereafter sued for and recovered, or otherwise duly made to appear, which there shall be no other assets to pay, that then and in every such case, if the said Amelia Lucrecia Bergman shall refund and pay back to the said Benjamin Erickson, executor, as aforesaid, her ratable part of such debt or debts, and of the costs of suit and charges, by reason of such debt or debts, out of the part or share so as aforesaid received by her thereby to enable the said executor to satisfy such debt or debts, then the above obligation to be void, or else to remain in full force and virtue.
