McPherson, directed by the order of the Orphans' Court of the County of Atlantic to be sold according to law; and further do make or cause to be made a just and true account of her administration within twelve calendar months from the date of the above obligation and the surplus of the money which shall be found remaining upon the account of such sale or sales, the same being first examined and allowed by the Orphans' Court of the County, or other competent authority shall distribute and pay unto such person or persons respectively, as is, are, or shall be by law entitled to receive the same, then the above obligation to be void and of none effect otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue.
