Atlantic County Orphans Court  
Decree.

In the matter of the Estate of  
Anna Ida Michel, deceased.

The order to show cause in this matter made on the thirteenth  
day of September, nineteen hundred and four, having been published ac-  
cording to law, and the court having heard and examined the  
allegations and proofs, and it appearing on examination that  
the personal estate of the said Anna Ida Michel, deceased, is not  
sufficient to pay her debts, and that Charles H. Schmidt, adminis-  
trator, has applied all the personal estate that has come to his  
hands to the payment of said debts, and that there is a de-  
ficiency amounting to the sum of nine hundred fifty five dollars  
and fifty four cents (\$955.54); It is thereupon, on this thirteenth  
day of November, nineteen hundred and four, ordered that the  
said Charles H. Schmidt, administrator as aforesaid, sell the  
following tract of land whereof the said Anna Ida Michel died  
seized to wit: All that certain tract of land situate in Egg  
Harbor City, in the County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey,  
beginning at a point on the southeast side of Chicago Ave  
nue, eighty feet northeasterly of Beethoven Street; thence running  
northeasterly along the said side of said avenue one hundred  
twenty feet, and of that width throughout, extending in length  
or depth southeasterly, parallel with Beethoven street one hundred  
fifty feet. Being lots numbers three, four and five in block  
488 on a map of Egg Harbor City, duly filed in the Clerk's Office  
of Atlantic County: to raise the said sum of nine hundred fifty  
five dollars and fifty four cents (\$955.54) for the payment of  
the debts of the said decedent, either at private or public sale,  
and that after making such sale, that the said Charles H.  
Schmidt report the same to this court for its approval and con-  
firmation.

And it is further ordered that before selling the aforesaid  
lands, the said Charles H. Schmidt, administrator as afore-  
said, shall enter into bond to the Ordinary of the State  
of New Jersey, with condition according to the Statute in  
such case made and provided, in the sum of twelve  
hundred dollars, with two or more sureties, to be approved  
by the court.
