An Petition, Order

Upon reading the petition of John Thirion and Anna Maria Thirion his wife, duly verified, wherein it is among other things prayed, that permission be granted them to adopt Asbely Keller, minor under the age of fourteen, pursuant to the provisions of the act concerning such, their adoption, custody and maintenance, approved April 2nd 1902, and the several supplements and amendments thereto, it is ordered, that the said petition and the affidavit thereto annexed, be filed with the clerk of this court;

And it appearing to the court, that it is for the interest of said child, that a discreet and suitable person be appointed as next friend to the said child without notice the court doth hereby appoint William Zimmerman next friend, for the purpose of adoption, and doth fix Tuesday, the thirteenth day of January next, at ten o'clock in the forenoon, at the Court House at Ocean Banding as the time and place, when and where he may give his consent in writing to the adoption of said infant, and the court may examine into the merits of the case and make such decree therein as shall seem proper, and for the best interest of said minor.

In the matter of the estate of Ernst Gross, deceased.

Order of Distribution

The first account of Peter A. Schenck, executor of the last will and testament of Ernst Gross, deceased, late of Egg Harbor City, in the County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey, having been duly filed, exhibiting a balance of Nine Thousand six hundred and fifty six dollars and thirty cents of the said estate in his hands up to the date of filing the same, and such account having been duly allowed by this court, and it appearing that the said Ernst Gross in and by his last will, duly probated in this court, gave, bequeathed and devised all of his estate and property, both real and personal, and wherever situate to his executor in trust to pay the net income therefrom to his brother, Louis Gross during his life, and upon his death, to divide and distribute the whole of the estate and property to and among Louis Gross Jr., Annie Glesner and Caroline Riegel, and the nine children now living of his brother-in-law, Peter Schenck, to take per capita and not per stirpes, then and each of their heirs and assigns; and it appearing that the said Louis Gross Jr. to whom the income for life was bequeathed, as aforesaid, departed this life antecedent to the death of said testator, to wit, on or about the second day of December 1894; and it further appearing that each of the said Louis Gross Jr., Annie Glesner and Caroline Riegel, and each of the said nine children of the late Peter Schenck, then and now living, are entitled to an equal one twelfth part of the aforesaid sum to be distributed, and that Peter A. Schenck, Matilda Wasthman, Bertha Wasthman, Anna Koll, Emma Kuehnle, Caroline Schenck, Emme Baake, Clara Kopf, and Gertrude Schenck, are the nine children of the said Peter Schenck, mentioned in the will; and it further appearing to the court that there remains after all debts and expenses having been allowed and deducted, the sum of nine thousand six hundred fifty six dollars and thirty cents in the hands of the said Peter A. Schenck, executor as aforesaid, for distribution in accordance with the terms of the said will; and it further appearing that due notice of this application has been given to all parties in interest.

It is thereupon on this Twenty-eighth day of December A.D. One thousand nine hundred and eight ordered that the aforesaid sum of nine thousand six hundred and fifty six dollars and thirty cents be distributed and paid in accordance with the directions and provisions of the said last will of Ernst Gross, as follows, to wit:
