Rossman and EIGHTEEN THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED AND FIFTY SEVEN DOLLARS AND SEVEN CENTS to James R. Rossman (allowance having been made for cash payments heretofore made)

deceased.) ORDER FOR DISTRIBUTION.
