I was born in Bonco Alessandria Italy, on the 18th day of March, anno Domini 1886; I now reside at 2216 Atlantic Ave. Atlantic City N.J. I emigrated to the United States of America from Havre France on the vessel Province Transatlantique; my last foreign residence was Bonco Alessandria Italy

It is my bona fide intention to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to Victor Emmanuel III King of Italy, of which I am now a citizen subject; I arrived at the port of New York City, in the State of New York, on or about the 27th day of Oct., anno Domini 1906; I am not an anarchist; I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and it is my intention in good faith to become a citizen of the United States of America and to permanently reside therein:
