I was born in Messina Italy on the 31st day of January, anno Domini 1890; I now reside at Hammonton New Jersey

I emigrated to the United States of America from Messina Italy on the vessel Calabria; my last foreign residence was Messina Italy

It is my bona fide intention to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to Victor Emmanuel III King of Italy
