In Memory of Elam Stockwell.

[At a meeting of the Directors of The Peoples Bank, held Tuesday evening, Jan. 18, 1910, the following thoughts incident upon the life and the death of Mr. Elam Stockwell were placed on the minute book of the institution, and copies of the same forwarded to the members of his family and the local papers.]

Again, following very closely upon the death of our honored President, Judge Byrnes, so closely that it is almost appalling, we have to record the death of another member of our banking family, that of Mr. Elam Stockwell, which occurred Sunday morning, Dec. 26th, 1909, after an illness of several weeks.

Mr. Stockwell was elected a director of this institution at its organization in March, 1887, thus having served continuously for twenty-three years, almost a quarter of a century.

Think of a group of men meeting in harmonious business relations, semi-weekly, for that length of time, and the great personal loss is apparent to all. Mr. Stockwell took great interest and pride in the institution from its very beginning. In fact, it was through his efforts, largely, that the institution was established, for he was able, through his large acquaintance with Philadelphia merchants, to obtain liberal subscriptions to its capital stock.

Mr. Stockwell's business career, commencing in a very humble way, in the late sixties, and later developing into what was then the largest business house in Hammonton, gave him a personal knowledge of our people which was invaluable. This knowledge, together with good business sagacity and more than the average amount of good hard common-sense, made him a most valuable director.

Around the Directors' table there is an empty chair, yet the room is filled with a thousand delightful memories, memories of an ever genial countenance, a frank utterance, a heart as tender as a woman's, and above all, the memories of that good fellowship which is ever present at gatherings of congenial men. Praise be to God for the privilege of such associations.

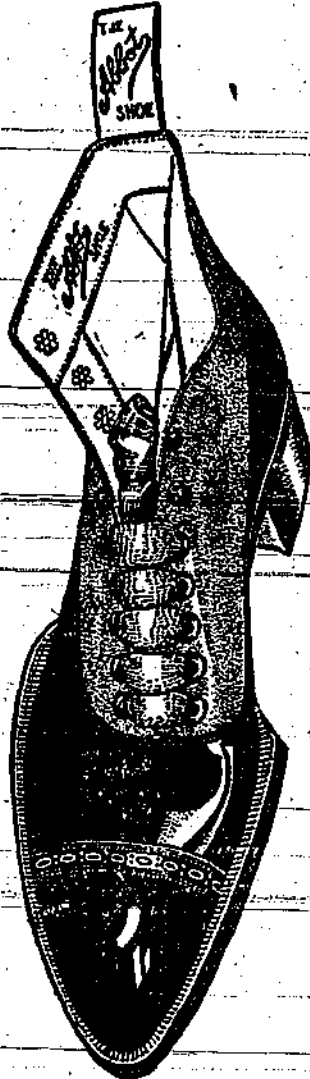
