Highway Committee reported that the approach to Volunteer Fire House had been replaced.

Fire, Water and Light Committee stated that the town gas ordinance specified street gas lamps at twenty dollars per year, and in their opinion twenty-five dollars, as now proposed by the company, could not be agreed to without making the agreement null and void.

bond of Collector Davis will expire on March 30th. It will be renewed.

Proposition from Gas Company for twenty 125-candle-power lamps at \$25 each per year. Considerable discussion followed. Decided to install the twenty lamps, provided the committee's report in regard to price is favorable. Special meeting to be held.

Broadway residents petitioned that their road be repaired and gravelled. As several "sand farms" border on Broadway, and blow dirt, Committee will have difficulty in deciding what to do about it.

Letter read from the Water Commissioners, asking for the issue of the balance of \$60,000 bonds voted by the town. Referred to special meeting.

Bonds for the three constables were read and accepted.

Ben. Foglietto's application for renewal of license was referred to the committee.

Petitions were read for gas light in the following localities: Horton and Pleasant Streets; Grape St., between Central and Valley Aves.; Orchard & Washington St.; Pleasant and Washington.

Typewritten decision was received of Thos. K. French, rendered by H. F. Stockwell, to the effect that the forty-five thousand dollars of water bonds will have to be re-issued, and signed by the present town officers.

Aid was asked for an aged man, G. O. Foster, formerly of Massachusetts, who needs aid to get back home. The Clerk instructed to write to the Massachusetts authorities.

At the request of Town Meeting, the Highway Committee was instructed to investigate gravel pits in various parts of town.

Voted, that owners of low hanging shade trees be notified to either trim the same or pay the town for having it done.

Discussion arose in regard to the following nuisances: sweeping trash into the gutters; obstructions on sidewalks; dumping trash on roadside. Committee instructed to make a list of offenders and give to the Clerk, for notification.

Property Committee instructed to employ B. F. Henshaw as janitor, at \$5 per month,--he to care for the hall, lock-up, and lot.

Highway Committee instructed to secure bids for three brick gutters under cross streets.

Residents on Bellevue wishing a cross-walk midway between Central Avenue and Second Street, Council agreed to pay one-half the cost, provided it did not exceed ten dollars.

The question of graveling Third St. near Cemetery Avenue, left with the committee.

Clerk O'Donnell receiving no compensation for office rent, asked that an office be provided, as he has an opportunity to rent the one he occupies. No action.

Council's confidence in Overseer Bernhouse was manifested by leaving to him the subject of rent and care for Frank Gialto's widow and children.

Reckless shooters were referred to Marshal Myers, who will notify several to stop that business.

The second warning to telephone companies was ordered sent,--to remove guy wires from shade trees in thirty days, or town will cut the said wires.

FEATS OF FAST WORK.  
Hospital Built and Made Ready to Re-  
ceive Patients in an Hour.  
In Austria a complete hospital was  
built and was made ready to receive  
patients in an hour. A few weeks  
ago almost impossible even when  
known that all the component parts of  
the building were at hand. It was in  
Austria, too, says a correspondent of  
the St. Louis Republic, that the seem-  
ingly miraculous task of converting  
trees into newspapers within two and  
a half hours was accomplished. At  
7:30 o'clock in the morning three trees  
were cut down at Eisenach. At 9:30  
the trees had been stripped of bark,  
cut up and converted into pulp, made  
into paper and passed the factory to  
the press, from which printed news-  
papers were issued at 10 o'clock.  
There are also some novel and as-  
tonishing feats in the production of  
books. Some years ago a publishing  
house in the Western States ordered  
an order to produce 2,000 copies of a  
work of 250 pages, bound in cloth, in  
three days. The work began on Mon-  
day and on Wednesday afternoon the  
2,000 volumes were handed over, and  
before Saturday no fewer than 20,000  
had been turned out.  
New York claims a publishing per-  
formance even more astonishing than  
this. An advance copy of one of Zola's  
works had been sent to Paris by an  
agent of the American firm, and it  
went to New York. On its arrival it  
was translated into English, put into  
type, printed and bound and was ac-  
companied on sale within twenty-four hours.  
Not long ago an English book-  
store turned out a pair of men's shoes  
in the amazingly short space of time  
of twenty minutes. The shoes in-  
cluded, among other parts, two sewed  
pieces, two inner soles, two stiffenings,  
two pieces of steel to give a spring,  
the insole, two bands, two sole lin-  
ings, thirty tacks, twelve nails in the  
heels and twenty buttons.  
Remarkable feats of swift work are  
accomplished by those who have to  
do with moving railroad bridges and  
building railroads and locomotives. The  
new bridge for the Great Northern  
railway at Flushing park was sub-  
stituted for the old one in the short space  
of four hours. The work started at  
4 o'clock in the morning, when power-  
ful cranes were set to work to remove  
the old structure. The new bridge, weighing  
more than 2,000 tons, which was resting  
near at hand on small carriages,  
was hauled into position by steel
