Sottings from Town Half.
The ordinance has gotten to "drat rending,", aod will be called up at a special meeting. What the next move will be depeods upon circumstances. At town meeting in Marcb, tho people ordered Council to procu:e two blue print copies of the old town map for live
dollare, the motion being offered by an dollare, the motion being offered by an J. C. Ander8on to expend $\$ 500$ for "uno fourth" of a whole map of the town,this first map to take in the buckleberry wilds of Atsion. The aseessors request ed that the blue prints be procured, but were refused by Council because the party who was to make the blue priats wanted bis money in advadce, which he had a right to ask, Thia little "faeco" may cost the town bomething more in the end.
Although refusing to draw an order as above, Council deliberately voted $\$ 15$ to Stephany \& Son in violatiot of law, his services (if any) not being specifed. His fer wbe for "oral advice"t to Mr. Cunningbam, Mr. Anderson, Mr. Logan, ajd "a man who represented himself as a member of Couscil," but whose of the parties tere authorized to ask for oral udvice (Mr. Cunnipgham being directed, I underatand, to write him), it is plain that Council bad no riybt to pay such a bill. The unknown party may have been a trump; but it is a sad apectacle whet the town must pay the "oral advice" bille of partice who may bave their own axes to griud, instead or those for the town. Afterward, Council pondered long and meditatively over th bill of a local physiciad, which was seut in io much better glape than tho law yer's, aod carcululy inemized.
