BONDS FOR OFFICIALS
 Council has decided to increase the
 bond of the Tax Collector and Treas-
 urer from \$15,000 to \$25,000. The
 Deputy Town Clerk who heretofore
 has not been compelled to furnish
 bonds, will be bonded in the modest
 sum of \$250. The members of the
 Sinking Fund Commission, who must
 furnish bonds in the sum of \$5000
 each, will not have to increase that
 amount during the present year. Coun-
 cil deeming \$5000 a large enough sum
 for those officials.

 heralded as a heroine for her splendid
 work on the night of the wreck of the
 "Midnight Flyer," she being in charge
 of the Bell telephone exchange here,
 was recently wedded to Aaron Bassett,
 a war veteran, of Hammonton.

HAMMONTON HUNTERS GET DEER
 A heavy rain caused many deer
 hunters to quit the deer fields early
 today. Three bucks, killed by Ham-
 monton hunters, have been reported.
 Two of these killed in Burlington
 county by a party of Hammonton
 hunters led by Peter T. Ranere, "king
 of the deer hunters," were a spike buck
 and a four-snag buck. Michael De
 Luca hunting by himself, brought in
 a 14-snag buck, killed in the vicinity
 of Chetwout. De Luca was in a pine
 tree when he saw five bucks passing.
 Selecting the biggest he fired and
 killed it, and permitted the others to
 go their way. Deer hunters say it was
 fully 20 years old.
