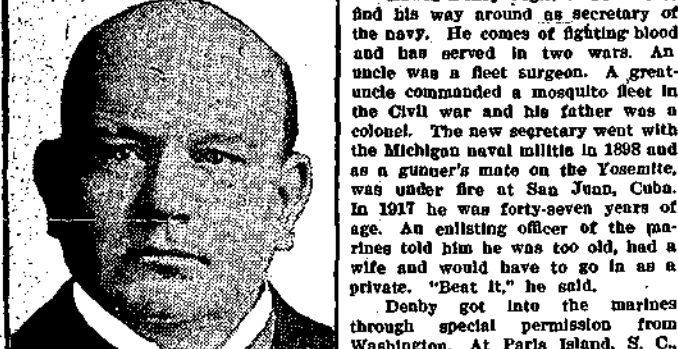

Denby, Veteran of Two Wars



Edwin Denby ought to be able to find his way around as secretary of the navy. He comes of fighting blood and has served in two wars. An uncle was a fleet surgeon. A great-uncle commanded a mosquito fleet in the Civil war and his father was a colonel. The new secretary went with the Michigan naval militia in 1898 and as a gunner's mate on the Yosemite, was under fire at San Juan, Cuba. In 1917 he was forty-seven years of age. An excellent officer of the police told him he was too old, had a wife and would have to go in as a private. "Beat it," he said.

Denby got into the Marines through special permission from Washington. At Fort Belvoir, S. C., he did lumber shoveling, concrete mixing and maintenance work like any other private. He was in the line with the first step in life of many public men—their military training.

Denby went abroad with his father, Cleveland's minister to Spain. He was graduated from the University of Michigan in 1900, and was admitted to the bar in 1902. He went to Congress in 1902 and served till 1911.
