## Large National Reading Class of 13,000

Washington, D. C., June 14.—The course usually requires three years. Each member must satisfy the Washington bureau when the book is given and when it is finished, including a summary of episodes and characters and the reader's impressions.

It cannot be understood that the bureau of education furnishes the books to be read; it simply furnishes courses of reading and encourages the cooperation of the state superintendent of public instruction as well as the directors of the extension division of state universities. Nine states are already actively co-operating in this work and heretofore, Iowa, Kentucky, North Carolina, Arizona, Wisconsin and North and South Dakota.

This reading circle embodies literature, history, geography, fiction, biography, scientific subjects such as shipbuilding, iron and steel, merchant marine and machine shop work, or many of the twenty-two countries of the world, India, China, Philippines, Iceland, Porto Rico, France and Canada.

Particularly in the reading course for boys of great value, for so many boys before he reaches years old, read without the advantage of schools, because of their own initiative.
